
Help your requested items arrive faster!

• Request items in a hardcopy or print format only. Electronic books or e-books <u>cannot</u> be requested and borrowed through interlibrary loan. Look for symbols (e) or text indicating that a title is an "electronic source," "e-book," "internet resource," or "computer file." Requests will be canceled if in e-book form.



 Put as much information as possible in the request form in the appropriate fields such as volume, month, or OCLC number, even if they are not automatically populated. You may need to go back to the record to find this information.
